- 7. Forrest MTB project, see community update September 2022. Les shared COS Update 27 March 2023. Highlights include



- a. works on all trails are now complete, with all trails open again to the public. Please note that new trails are to be ridden with caution over the first year as the final surface beds in.
- b. Work on the Skills Park has now completed. New features include a large asphalt pump track, An Adaptive Rider Pump Track, Two jumps lines catering for both advanced and novice riders, A set of skills courses with three levels of difficulty.
- c. Works on the Forrest trailhead is continuing including the installation of two new picnic shelters, water at the trailhead for both drinking and handwashing, and some landscaping to the general area. The trailhead will be closed during construction.
- d. Work on an Entry Arch for the Trailhead precinct is continuing, and moving into the detailed design phase of the project.
- e. Expect to see permanent directional signage around the trail network soon. Signage will include the trails new branding, clearer wayfinding and make the system much safer for all user groups.
- f. Works are still in progress for finalising the network map and other information to go at the trailhead.
