





7:30 pm | The dish (M) | (2000) A remote Australian community, populated by quirky characters, plays a key role in the first Apollo moon landing. Director Rob Sitch, starring Sam Neill, Billy Mitchell, Roz Hammond. 1 hour 41 minutes running time. |

7:30 pm | Woman at war (M) | (2018) Halla is a 50-year-old independent Icelandic woman. She is a respected choir leader who lives a double life, secretly waging a one-woman-war on the local aluminium industry. She risks everything to conserve the pristine Icelandic highlands. Director Benedikt Erlingsson, starring Halldora Geirhardsdottir. 1 hour 41 minutes running time. |

7:30 pm | Gallipoli (M) | (1981) Several young men from Western Australia enlist in the Australian Army during the First World War and are sent to the Gallipoli campaign in Turkey. The young men slowly lose their innocence about the purpose of war. Director Peter Weir, starring Mel Gibson, Mark Lee. 1 hour 50 minutes running time. |

7:30 pm | The book thief (PG) | (2013) While subjected to the horrors of World War II Germany, young Liesel finds solace by stealing books and sharing them with others. In the basement of her home, a Jewish refugee is being protected by her adoptive parents. Director Brian Percival, starring Geoffrey Rush and Sophie Nelisse. Running time 2 hours 11 minutes. |

7:30 pm | Gurrumul (PG) | (2017) This moving documentary tells the story of Geoffrey Gurrumul Yunupingu, an Aboriginal musician celebrated as one of Australia's most distinctive voices. It is a portrait of an artist on the brink of global reverence, and the struggles he and those closest to him faced in balancing that which mattered most to him and keeping the show on the road. Director Paul Damien Williams, starring Gurrumul, Mark Grose. Running time 1 hour 36 minutes. |
